

Dear Homeowners,

As you have probably heard on the News, the Naples area is experiencing a moderate level of drought. Areas to the north of us are in severe drought.

Because of this drought, the Greenscapes supervisor, Brian Marcinowski, has recommended that Service Requests for the installation of sod be placed on hold until further notice.

New sod requires extra watering to thrive, and increasing the amount of irrigation needed for new sod would not be wise at this time.

The Landscape Committee Chairperson supports this recommendation.

Please withhold submitting any Service Requests for sod replacement or note that if you submit a request for sod, it will not be completed until the threat of drought is passed.

Requests for weed and pest control are not included and will be addressed as received.

For any requests related to plant replacements in our Landscape Services, you may still submit them; however, please be aware that if the drought situation worsens significantly, we may need to postpone planting decisions.

Additionally, you can meet with the Greenscapes Landscape Supervisor on Tuesday mornings from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM to discuss any concerns you have regarding your landscape.
